ABOUT THE ARTIST

Born in Tuktoyaktuk, NT, Angus Nuligak Cockney
is an Inuit multi-media artist, speaker, and former
cross-country skier. He participated in the 1989
"Ice Walk" North Pole expedition and has been
known as the Icewalker ever since.

Known for his contemporary interpretations
of Northern traditions and culture—particularly
through stone sculpture work—Angus is now
based in Canmore, Alberta and maintains a
studio at his Rocky Mountain home. He also
regularly undertakes commissions and speaking
tours throughout Canada and abroad.

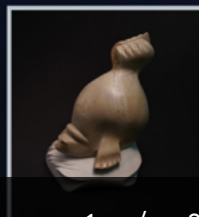

Avunnivik in Eskimo. The true
seals bring forth their young.
These develop and become the
seals we hunt.
